Learn how to script and facilitate a virtual class

Target

This program is intended for heads of L&D, learning professionals, occasional or professional facilitators, coaches and business experts.

Requirements

To take this course, you must have already facilitated face-to-face learning programs and know how to manage a group of learners. The facilitation basics will not be reviewed in this course.

Technical requirements

To follow the program, you will need a computer (with a camera) and access to internet.

Duration

The program lasts 12 hours spread over 4 weeks:

- 3 virtual classes of 2 hours each
- Digital program (videos and resources)
- Individual work (asynchronous trainings)

Access
